Valbrembo / Barcelona, 8 May 2026 - Evoca Group announces that its subsidiary Quality Espresso has informed employee representatives and trade unions of its intention to streamline its Spanish manufacturing footprint, including the proposed discontinuation of production lines at the Zona Franca site in Barcelona, currently dedicated to the production and development of traditional coffee machines and grinders.

The proposed measure is part of a broader plan to adapt Quality Espresso's industrial setup to current market conditions and to support the long-term competitiveness and sustainability of the business.

In recent years, the traditional coffee machine segment has been affected by changes in customer demand, increased pressure on costs and a more competitive environment. These factors have led Quality Espresso to assess the most appropriate measures to align its industrial capacity with market needs.

The proposed reorganisation would involve the intention to start a collective dismissal procedure and the related consultation process with employee representatives, in accordance with Spanish labour law.

Quality Espresso will continue to operate in the Spanish market. The Zona Franca site will remain active as a regional hub, maintaining commercial, after-sales, logistics and support activities.

Evoca Group and Quality Espresso are committed to managing the process responsibly and to engaging in a constructive dialogue with employee representatives and the relevant institutions.
